Guideline # 23 Landscape Edging

Landscape edging for grass, plant beds, trees, shrubs, flower beds and other areas located within the grounds of the homeowner's landscape must be approved by the Modification Committee (MC) prior to any installation. All landscape edging must be properly maintained during the life of the edging.

Any edging installed may not exceed eight (8) inches in height from the ground level. Edging must be comprised of either painted concrete, natural edging stones, steel, rubber, or aluminum and must be of a natural color. Muted shades that are typically found in nature are permitted and all edging must be approved by the Modification Committee before being installed. (No silver or other non-natural colors).

The homeowner must provide a detailed landscape drawing or survey clearly outlining the locations of all landscape edging that will be installed.

Landscape edging must be installed between grass areas and river rocks. This is to protect our landscapers from any possibility of flying rocks that could injure a worker or that might damage vehicles and other items.

White rocks are not permitted in Country Club East for the use of landscape edging, or in any landscape beds.

Homeowners are required to submit color photos of each type of edging, color and sizes of edging being installed to the MC. (photos of some acceptable edgings are attached)
